Policies that I support:

Addressing the Climate and Ecological Emergency

- Must be economically sensible
 - Rapid Investment in renewables & battery, not gas/coal. We should have a surplus of energy to unlock capabilities - 800% renewables in 10 years target.
 - Rapid investment in manufacturing and research & development.
 - No power shortages or price spikes Switch off only when renewables take over.
- Logging must immediately stop
 - Building materials made from recycled plastics.
 - Agroforestry to plant more trees for harvesting.
 - Protect native species like the critically endangered Leadbeater's Possum which is Victoria's state emblem, and many others.

Good Governance

- Community Consultation
 - Everything (including my other policies) must be properly consulted with the community in a meaningful way.
 - I will run my own consultations to get community feedback and vote, on all issues.
 - No more surprise speed limit changes, or extended over-the-top lockdowns etc. without broad community support.
- Balance of Power

Protected Bike Paths

- Current bike lanes are dangerous, making them impractical to use, Bikes, Cars and Pedestrians need to be completely separate from each other.
