WATER/ AGRICULTURE

One Nation Victoria supports the proposed expansion of the Big Buffalo dam wall. Farmers require 100% of their water allocation at the beginning of the irrigation season if dams are at capacity. Extending to 120% throughout the season if water storage allows.

HEALTH

Australia's health system was beyond capacity prior to COVID-19 and evidently inadequate in regional areas. One Nation recognises the need to bolster the number of regional doctors, nurses, paramedics and other critical health professionals. In an effort to encourage better regional medical services, One Nation will introduce three-year contracts for newly qualified medical professionals and in return pay their HECS-HELP loans in full.

EDUCATION

Despite a \$24.8 billion Federal budget for state education services, Australia continues to rank lower than comparable high- and middle-income countries in achieving quality education outcomes. One Nation Victoria will restore critical thinking in the classroom and reinstate the cornerstone of education with reading, writing, arithmetic, and discipline. There should be no room for Western, white, gender, guilt shaming in any classroom and instead children should be taught the benefits of a merit-based, free-thinking society.

FUEL

One Nation Victoria advocates for the expansion of fuel storage facilities at the Geelong refinery. We desperately need to increase our fuel reserves from the current 14 days, to the recommended 90 days capacity for both strategic and domestic benefit. Also to better utilize Victorias vast reserves of natural gas for local use.

TRANSPORT & STATE BUILDING INFRASTRUCTURE / PROGRAMS

In order to support Victoria's growth. One Nation Victoria advocates for the construction of regional 'state building' road and rail infrastructure projects. These have the triple benefit of encouraging industry, and the jobs associated with these industries into regional areas. Also. The easing of congestion in suburban/ metropolitan centers. We do not support the Labor governments plan to persist with the already over budget 'Metro Link' project in its current form. We'll also advocate for more parking at train stations and the implementation of Park & Ride programs.

ENERGY

One Nation Victoria continues to support affordable, dispatchable, base load power through coal generated power plants. To be used in conjunction with and supplemented by the addition of the proposed second Bass Straight interconnector (Marinus Link). To bring hydro electric energy from Tasmania to assist supply in Victoria. This is affordable, proven, clean, green & efficient energy.

VACCINE MANDATES

One Nation Victoria firmly opposes any and all COVID 19 vaccination mandates/ requirements. We promote sovereignty of the individual over all else. Neither employers nor governments reserve the right to impede on any persons bodily autonomy.

HOUSING

One Nation Victoria will work with local councils to remove lengthy processes and administrative red tape on the subdivision of new land releases. These processes serve only to imply land scarcity. This is a driving factor in soaring land prices.

We'll also stop the sale of housing to foreign investors and nonresidents. Victorian housing is for Victorians.

GOVERNANCE

Victoria needs to implement IBAC/ VO recommendations. As strong advocates for anti-corruption and vocal proponents against increasing government overreach. We'll demand more transparency and more accountability. We'll also continue the push for a Royal Commission into the management of the COVID 19 pandemic and subsequent mandates.

SOCIAL & ECONOMIC INCLUSION

We have an extensive history of volunteering within our Victorian communities. In our collective efforts to encourage volunteers and their networks back into action post COVID 19. We support the 'Victorian Volunteering Strategy' Better management of community grants programs. The establishment of innovation hubs, co-working spaces and remote working hubs to support a more flexible workforce.

RELIGIOUS FREEDOM

One Nation Victoria believes in the inalienable right to freedom of thought, conscience and religion. All persons reserve the right to religious freedom. To both believe in, teach, practice and/or observe in ones religious traditions. Provided that these practices don't impede on or take precedence over Australian laws, nor encroach on the rights or freedoms of other individuals or groups.
